

GEORGE L. WATTERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Amount: \$1,000 minimum

Eligibility: Graduating seniors from any high school in Nebraska

Criteria: Offspring of a Nebraska Petroleum Marketer employee, will attend college in

Nebraska, upper 1/3 of high school class.

The George L. Watters Memorial Scholarship was established in 1988. George Watters was an outstanding and well-respected representative of the petroleum marketing industry. Following his death several years ago, the Nebraska Petroleum Marketers Association established this scholarship to properly recall George's leadership and integrity in the field. The Nebraska Petroleum Marketers, a member of the Petroleum Marketers Association of America, seeks to unify petroleum marketers throughout the state to effectively further the common interests of the petroleum marketing industry.

CRITERIA

- **1.** Applicant must be the offspring of a current member of the Nebraska Petroleum Marketer or their employee.
- 2. Must be a current graduating high school senior from any high school in Nebraska.
- 3. Must attend a college or university in Nebraska.
- **4.** Must be in the upper one-third of the graduating class and must demonstrate leadership qualities and have expressed a desire and intent to continue education leading to a degree.
- 5. Financial need will only be utilized as a tie-breaker in the selection process.

APPLICATION

Applicants are required to complete the Lincoln Community Foundation Application Form and submit the form and all required attachments to the Nebraska Petroleum Marketers Association. Applications must be postmarked or delivered by March 15th to:

Application required attachments:

- **1.** High school transcript(s) (copies of transcripts are acceptable).
- 2. Three (3) letters of recommendation (no more than one year old). Letters must be written by teachers, counselors, case workers, clergy, employers, neighbors, etc. (letters from family members are not acceptable). Submit letters of recommendation with your application materials.
- **3. Essay:** *Explain how you are related to member or member's employee of NPCA.* Your essay should be no more than 250 words and be typed on no more than 1 attached page.
- **4.** Financial Information that shows **Expected Family Contribution (EFC) number,** which is on the <u>first</u> page of the applicant's Student Aid Report (SAR).

DEADLINE

Scholarship applications must be postmarked or delivered to Grafton & Associates by March 15th.

AWARD

The Nebraska Petroleum Marketers Association Scholarship Committee will review all applications and send recommendations to the Lincoln Community Foundation. The Foundation will make the final selection of scholarship recipients.

Scholarship checks will be sent directly to the student's college or university. Scholarship grants can be made only to qualified, nonproprietary institutions.

This scholarship shall not be awarded to any immediate or distant member of the George L. Watters Family.
